

WINTER FARMER-RANCHER MARKET-2009  
FARMER AND RANCHER NETWORK – CORSICANA, TEXAS  
GENERAL RULES/GUIDELINES

1. Only actual farmers and ranchers or their designated representatives, who produce food and agricultural products, will be allowed to participate at this Market.
2. All food and agricultural products must be pre-approved, pending submission of a list of items you wish to sell.
3. The Market Coordinator will have the discretion to add or delete items from the list and has the duty to provide notice to the seller(s).
4. Designation and allocation of selling spaces shall be the responsibility of the Market Coordinator.
5. All sellers must abide by the health code and any restrictions of the City of Corsicana, Navarro County and the State of Texas. Copies of all required permits and/or licenses must be provided to the Market Coordinator before Market Day.
6. Providing “cut” or otherwise “open” food samples for tasting, smelling or texture shall not be permitted.
7. No potentially hazardous product will be permitted for sale.
8. All items intended for human consumption shall be kept off the ground at all times and shall be in a safe and sound condition. The seller shall be solely responsible for damages resulting from the sale of unsafe or unsound goods.
9. A Saturday Only Market, held in November and December 2009, hours of operation will be from 8:00 a.m. to 12:00 noon. NO VENDOR WILL BE ALLOWED TO SET-UP AFTER MARKET OPENS AT 8:00 A.M.
10. All sellers must be set-up and ready for business no more than 1 hour before the opening of Market.
11. Once the Market has begun, no moving vehicles shall be allowed in the Market area as a safety precaution
12. Sellers are responsible for the following:
  - All display materials, tables, tents, etc. and containers for customer sales
  - Determining pricing and display of their products
  - Cleanliness of selling space during/after and removal of all trash at the end of Market
  - Wearing appropriate attire for doing business with customers from all walks of life
  - Any extension cords must be contain no frayed /exposed wires and all extension cords must be taped down and secured for safety reasons
13. A standard selling space will be 10' x 10'. The fee will be listed on vendor application.
14. NO firearms, alcoholic beverages or drugs will be allowed at the Winter Farmer and Rancher Market.
15. It is understood that on the vendor application that I (we) must initial that I (we) have received and do agree to abide by these General Rules/Guidelines.
16. Any violation of these guidelines or any future guidelines issued during the term of this Market will be considered a breach and default by the vendor. Such vendor will not be allowed to return to participate at Market until or if issues can be resolved to the satisfaction of Market Coordinator or their designee(s).
